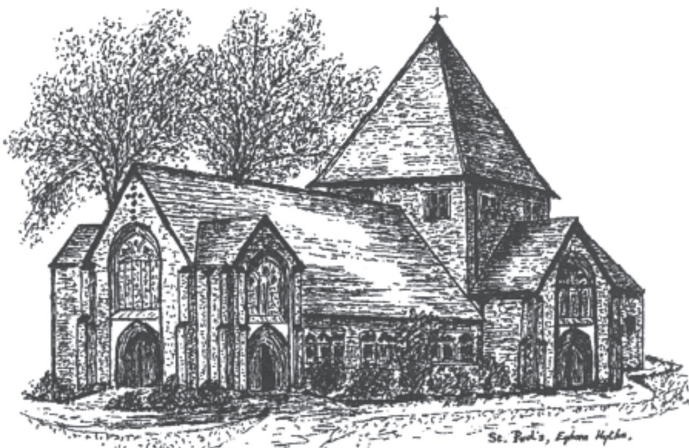
Keeping the Church
